Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) program

Summary of Eligibility Criteria for Referring Agencies (RAs) and SEE Providers

Who is eligible for the SEE program?

Clients are eligible to undertake the SEE program when they meet **all** the following criteria:

- ✓ working age (between 15 years and Age Pension age)
- ✓ registered as a job seeker
- ✓ deemed suitable for training without any barriers that would prevent successful participation
- ✓ either an Australian citizen or permanent resident or have working rights in Australia.

Who is NOT eligible for the SEE program?

Clients are **not eligible** to undertake the SEE program if they are:

- ✗ a full-time student at the time of referral
- ✗ undertaking New Enterprise Incentive Scheme (NEIS); the Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) or any other program advised from time to time
- ✗ a person who has exited the program and are seeking a referral within three months of their last exit/program completion date, except where they are transferring to a new provider
- ✗ current holders of a Skilled Migrant Visa
- ✗ currently a secondary visa holder of a person who holds a Skilled Migrant Visa (dependent).
